
### How To Start Your Gas Fireplace



and we're here to talk you through some steps to help you get your fireplace going.

Below are some quick, high-level steps

First off, fireplaces are extremely safe

we put together to help you get your gas fireplace started. (Chances are these steps won't be quite what you need. Check your owner's manual / manufacturer for more specific information.)

# WHAT KIND OF APPLIANCE DO YOU HAVE?

START WITH STEP ONE

**DIRECT VENT OR B-VENT** 

SKIP TO STEP TWO

**GAS LOGS** 

#### REMOVE THE FRONT PLATING or open the access panel on your fireplace

STEP ONE

#### LOCATE THE "GAS SUPPLY LINE" Find the valve on the gas supply line and turn the

valve so that it is **parallel** to the gas supply line.

LOCATE THE PILOT ASSEMBLY'S

-STEP FOUR -

CHECK THE ELECTRICAL SWITCH

or remote-control receiver on the pilot assembly's

spark ignitor and ensure the system is positioned

In most gas inserts / logs, an electrical charge is

initiated to light the fire. If the system is left on,

to "Off."

you could get burned by an accidental ignition.

Turn the switch to "Off" and have no fear!

STEP FIVE

LOCATE THE VALVE CONTROL

regulator. It should have the words, "On," Off,"

and "Pilot." Depress the knob and rotate it until

the word "Pilot" is in the 6 o'clock position. Hold

it in this position.

STEP SIX

LOCATE THE IGNITER BUTTON
near the valve regulator control and press the
button down at 1-second intervals until the pilot
is lit.

control knob in position for 1 minute and then slowly position the valve control so that the "On" position is at the 6 o'clock.

Once the pilot has been lit, hold the valve

# RETURN THE ELECTRICAL SWITCH

STEP SEVEN

or remote-control receiver and position the

system into the "On" position.

or close the access panel to its original alignment.
