2. What type of fireplace?

- Fireplace insert (goes into an existing fireplace)
- Freestanding fireplace or woodstove (sets in your room)
- Fireplace in a wall (may or may not have a mantle)

3. What style do you want?

- Traditional Logs with granite, stone, brick surround and with mantle
- Contemporary fuel bed with glass beads or Driftwood or broken glass
- Minimal and Clean
- Mixture of Styles

4. What fuel?

- Not Sure
- Cord Wood (must have a place to store and season)
- Natural Gas (must have access to pipe line supply from PSNC)
- Propane Gas (must have a tank somewhere in your yard)

- Electric
- Pellet Fuel
- Alternative fuel (feed corn, etc.)

5. What are the extra's?

- New mantle
- New surround (tile, brick, stone, granite, marble, clean face)
- New hearth Extension (Raised, No hearth extension)

FEATURES OF 21ST CENTURY GAS & WOOD APPLIANCES

Features that Charlie likes
about High Efficiency Wood
Burning.



- Ceramic Glass with the “air wash” technology - this feature bathes the glass with the hot air in the stove (1000+ degrees) which burns the soot of the glass
- Aurora Borealis Affect (Charlie’s terminology) - the wood does not have flames coming off of them but hovers, swirls, and rolls above the wood. A real flame show in your own family room!
- So simple to operate - Many stove models have a single lever to operate
- Stingy on the wood consumption. The secondary burn system really cuts the emissions. You get more heat into your home with less wood and less pollution.

Features that Charlie likes
about High Efficiency Gas
Burning.



- Direct Vent technology translates into none of your homes conditioned air goes up the chimney. Two Colinear 3” pipes go from the top of the appliance to the top of the chimney. Fresh air to feed the fire comes down one pipe. The products of combustion from the fire goes up the other pipe.
- With a Valor Gas Fireplace you don't need power to enjoy the heat and the beauty. No power- no problem
- No mess, no smells
- You don't need to heat the whole house to get a delightfully cozy room.
